

Panagiotis-Leonidas Gofas

Panagiotis-Leonidas Gofas was born on December 20, 1965, in Melbourne, Australia. He attended secondary school at the Hellenic-French College DelaSalle and graduated in 1983. In the same year, he entered the School of Law and Economics at the University of Thessaloniki, where he pursued studies in economics with a focus on business administration and finance. During his time at Aristotle University, he contributed to the writing of university textbooks. He graduated in 1988 and continued his studies in New York, earning a Master's degree in Catering and Costing, as well as an MBA from the University of Macedonia (PA.MA.K).

In 1988, he became a member of the Economic Chamber of Greece. Since 1992, he has been involved in the restaurant and food business. In 1992, he married English Literature professor Paulette Athanasiadi, and they have three children: Kristi, Vivi, and Nicole.

In 1992, Gofas took over the family SME in the restaurant industry, "Hamodrakas." In 1995, he created a Catering department for organizing and managing receptions. He has been continuously involved in the food service industry since 1996.

In 1996, he was elected General Secretary of the Thessaloniki Restaurant Owners Association. In 1997, he was elected as a member of the Board of Directors and special advisor to the Panhellenic Federation of Restaurant Owners and Related Professions. He also became a member of the Pan-European Union Eurotogue that same year.

Gofas was elected to the Board of Directors of the Thessaloniki Chamber of Commerce in 1997. From 1997 to 2006, he served as president of the Panhellenic Federation of Restaurant and Related Professions. From 2006 to 2025, he represented the General Confederation of Greek Workers (GSEVEE) in the European Economic and Social Committee (EESC).

He was elected vice-president of the Economic & Monetary Section from 2008 to 2013 and president of the Broad Economic Policy Guidelines Council during the same period. From 2017 to 2025, he served as president of the Avignon Academy, representing SMEs in Europe.

Gofas was elected president of the SME category in the EESC from 2013 to 2018. From 2018 to 2021, he served as president of the Joint Consultative Committee (JCC) EU-Turkey. He was also an EC Expert on food loss and waste in 2020. From 2020 to 2025, he served as the dean of the EESC.
